



Evergreen Azaleas

Name	Colour	Height	Width	Bloom	Plant Characteristics
Bollywood	Reddish Pink	2-3'	2-3'	Mid-Spring	Gorgeous neon red-pink flowers stand out against the silver and green variegated foliage.
Coral Bells	Coral Pink	2-3'	3-5'	Mid-Spring	Coral pink blooms stand out against dark green, spreading foliage.
Fairy Pillow	White	8-10"	16-20"	Late Spring	Huge masses of semi-double white flowers.
Girard's Fuchsia	Deep Pink	2-4'	2-4'	Early Spring	Single deep pink flowers with wavy edges.
Girard's Pleasant White	White	3-4'	3-4'	Mid-Late	An abundance of pure white flowers.
Girard's Rose	Red	2-4'	3-5'	Mid-Spring	Gorgeous rose-red blooms in mid-Spring.
Gumpo Pink	Pink	1-2'	2-3'	Late Spring	Pink single flowers cover this low growing azalea.
Hino Crimson	Crimson Red	2-3'	2-3'	Early Spring	Red flowers cover this compact growing azalea.
Hino White	Pure White	12-14"	6-10"	Mid-Spring	Very compact, does well in rockeries and small gardens. Spreads nicely.
Louise Gable	Salmon	2-3'	2-3'	Late Spring	Double flower stands out against dark green foliage.
Rosebud	Bright Pink	2-3'	2-3'	Mid-Spring	Double pink flowers and dark green foliage.
White Rosebud	White	2-4'	2-4'	Mid-Spring	Beautiful double-white flowers cover this shrub in spring.



Re-Blooming Azaleas

Name	Colour	Height	Width	Bloom	Plant Characteristics
Bloom-A-Thon Hot Pink	Hot Pink	3-4'	3-4'	Spring, Summer & Fall	Vivid semi-double pink flowers with freckled throats. Great compact growth habit.
Bloom-A-Thon Lavender	Lavender	3-5'	3-4'	Spring, Summer & Fall	Gorgeous purple flowers in spring, summer & fall. Great for containers.
Bloom-A-Thon Pink Double	Pink	3-5'		Spring, Summer & Fall	Large, double pink flowers in all 3 seasons. Great for planting as a border.





Re-Blooming Azaleas

Name	Colour	Height	Width	Bloom	Plant Characteristics
Bloom- A- Thon Red	Red	3-5'	3-4'	Spring, Summer & Fall	Bright red flowers in spring, summer & fall. Great for planting in part shade gardens.
Bloom-A-Thon White	White	2-3'	2-3'	Spring, Summer & Fall	Pure white flowers. Shortest growing re-blooming Azalea. Great for small yards.
Perfecto Mundo Double Pink	Pink	3'	3'	Spring, Summer & Fall	Blooms in Spring when other Azaleas bloom, then again in mid summer until it frosts.

Deciduous Azaleas

Very few shrubs can stand up against the Deciduous Azalea for showiness and colour range. Blooms range from yellows and oranges to reds and whites. Foliage turns brilliant red to maroon in fall. Deciduous Azaleas are extremely hardy and perform well in the interior of British Columbia.

Cannon's Double	Pink	4'	6'	Late Spring	Showy light pink flowers, with red accents.
Gibraltar	Light Pink	4-8'	4-6'	Mid-Spring	Double flowers of rich cream and pink. Beautiful fall foliage.
Golden Lights	Bright Yellow	4-8'	4-6'	Mid-Spring	Gorgeous yellow blooms are fragrant!
Irene Koster	Pink	8'	8'	Late-Spring	Sweetly scented 2½-inch white blooms flushed with strong pink coloring.
Klondyke	Golden Yellow	4-8'	4-6'	Mid-Spring	Vivid orange-yellow buds open to golden-yellow flowers. New foliage emerges bronze.
Mother's Day	Crimson	3'	3'	Mid-Spring	Clusters of lightly-scented crimson trumpet-shaped flowers at the ends of the branches in mid spring before the leaves.
Northern Hi-Lights	Creamy White	4'	5'	Mid-Spring	Tall upright habit and good fall color; absolutely must have well-drained.
Pink & Sweet	Light Pink	4-5'	3-4'	Late Spring	Fragrant, semi-double light pink flowers.
Snowbird	Cream	4-6'	4-6'	Spring	Fragrant white blooms appear in early midseason, before the handsome blue-green foliage emerges.

Deciduous Azaleas

Very few shrubs can stand up against the Deciduous Azalea for showiness and colour range. Blooms range from yellows and oranges to reds and whites. Foliage turns brilliant red to maroon in fall. Deciduous Azaleas are extremely hardy and perform well in the interior of British Columbia.
