

Name	Deciduous or Evergreen	Clumping or Running	Height	Plant Characteristics
Arundinaria gigantea	Evergreen	Running	15-20'	This bamboo is very hard and can withstand temperatures as low as -20 degrees Celcius.
Arundinaria variegata	Evergreen	Running	4'-6'	New leaves are white with a bright green stripe.
Bambusa multiplex 'Wang Tsai'	Evergreen	Clumping	5-6'	Beautiful clumping variety. Needs winter protection or to be planted in a sheltered location.
Borinda boliana 'Blue Mountain'	Evergreen	Clumping	10-16'	New canes emerge burgundy-purple. Can be deciduous if we experience a cold winter.
Chimonobambusa marmorea	Evergreen	Running	2'-5'	Canes are light tan-green and can turn a bright red in direct morning sun.
Fargesia 'Blue Fountain'	Evergreen	Clumping	12' – 15'	Great for hedging. Very hardy-perfect for west coast gardens. Performs best in part shade.
Fargesia murielae	Evergreen	Clumping	10-14'	New shoots emerge soft blue and change to light yellow over time. Foliage turns bright yellow in fall.
Fargesia nitida	Evergreen	Clumping	10-12'	Canes are dark brown with bluish overtones when young. This bamboo is extremely tough.
Fargesia nitida 'Great Wall'	Evergreen	Clumping	6-10'	The hardiest of all bamboo with slender branching and dark purplish-canes. Perfect for shade gardens.
Fargesia nitida 'Green Panda'	Evergreen	Clumping	6-8'	Another cold hardy bamboo. Perfect for privacy screens and hedging.
Fargesia nitida 'Jiuzhaigou' (Red Dragon)	Evergreen	Clumping	8-12'	Beautiful red canes age to yellow. Great for containers. Very hardy.
Fargesia robusta 'Green Screen'	Evergreen	Clumping	12-16'	This bamboo is very fast growing. It is perfect for screens or hedging. Performs best in full sun.
Fargesia rufa	Evergreen	Clumping	8-10'	A very vigorous grower that is extremely cold hardy. Makes a wonderful screen.
Fargesia rufa 'Sunset Glow'	Evergreen	Clumping	6-8'	This bamboo is perfect for smaller gardens. Can withstand more sun than most other Fargesias.
Fargesia scabrida	Evergreen	Clumping	12-14'	Great clumping bamboo that makes a wonderful hedge. Larger leaves than other Fargesia varieties.

Fargesia scabrida 'Asian Wonder'	Evergreen	Clumping	10-12'	Some of the best colors of all clumping bamboo. Young canes are dark orange that turn purple and then slowly fade to deep green.
Phyllostachys kwangsiensis 'Moso of the North'	Evergreen	Running	16-20'	Also known as Giant Bamboo. Canes be as large as 5" across at maturity.
Phyllostachys 'Atrovaginata'	Evergreen	Running	30-40'	Very vigorous grower. New shoots have a strong scent and unusual pattern.
Phyllostachys aurea	Evergreen	Running	20'-25'	Easy to grow medium sized bamboo. Excellent privacy screen for that area just above your fence line.
Phyllostachys edulis 'Moso Jacqueline'	Evergreen	Running	20-30'	One of the largest growing bamboos. Grows very quickly. Very large canes – up to 7" in diameter.
Phyllostachys nigra	Evergreen	Running	15'-25'	Jet-black stems and lush feathery green leaves. New stems emerge green and gradually turn black in 2-3 years.
Phyllostachys vivax	Evergreen	Running	30-40'	Very vigorous grower. One of the quickest growing bamboos in the Northwest. Canes can grow as large as 5" in diameter.
Pseudosasa japonica	Evergreen	Running	10-15'	Excellent for screens. Can tolerate more wind than most bamboo. Great for seaside plantings.
Sasaella ramosa	Evergreen	Running	1-3'	Great groundcover. Can tolerate full sun or full shade. Can defoliate in colder winters.
Sasaella ramosa (Groundcover Bamboo)	Semi-Evergreen	Running	1.5'-3'	Thrives in a wide variety of soils and sun tolerant. Excellent ground cover for large areas, poor soils or bank stabilization.
