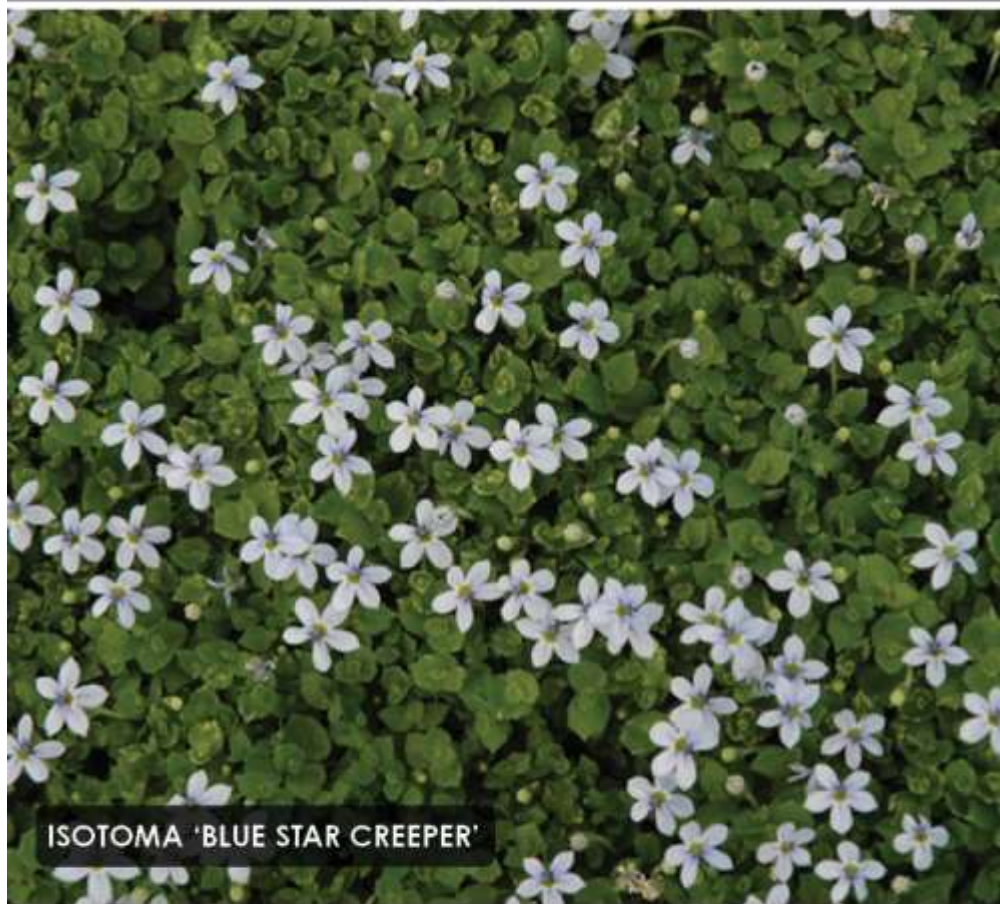

Groundcovers are an integral aspect of any garden. They hide difficult areas, decrease the need for weeding, and add interest with blooms and various foliage textures. Some are aromatic, making them a welcome addition around living areas like patios and pathways.

How to Plant:

If planting a larger area, space each plant between 12" and 18" apart depending on vigorousness and container size. Use Home & Garden Excellence Perennial Mix to plant in.

When to Plant:

The best times to plant your groundcovers are spring and fall. It is also acceptable to plant in summer, just make sure they are irrigated well.



























Fertilization:

Fertilize your groundcovers with an all-purpose fertilizer such as Home & Garden Excellence All Purpose 2kg in spring and early summer.






















Diseases and Pests:

Make sure your groundcovers are in the proper location, as many of them are susceptible to root rot.

Species	Exposure	Height / Spread	Foliage	Zone	Description
Ajuga reptans (Bugleweed)	  	8" x 18"	Evergreen	To -38°C	Blue flower spikes, green, variegated and burgundy foliage varieties. Fast growing.
Arctostaphylos uva- ursa (Kinnikinnick)		6" x 24"	Evergreen	To -35°C	Drought tolerant, native plant, erosion control, and slow growing. Pink/White flowers in spring, red berries and turning bronze in winter.
Arenaria balearica (Corsican Sandwort)	  	2" x 18"	Evergreen	To -35°C	Tolerant of light foot traffic. Moss-like carpet. White flowers in late spring. Requires consistent moisture.
Campanula carpatica (Bellflower)	 	5" x 18"	Semi- Evergreen	To -45°C	Blue or white flowers, semi-evergreen, excellent edger.
Convallaria majalis (Lily of the Valley)	  	8" x 18"	Deciduous	To -45°C	Slow to establish, fragrant blooms, dies down in winter
Cornus canadensis (Bunchberry)	  	4" x 12"	Semi- Evergreen	To -45°C	Slow to establish, small dogwood type flowers, good fall colour, red berries summer to fall. Native and deer resistant.
Cotoneaster dammeri (Cotoneaster)	 	12" x 5'	Evergreen	To -28°C	Drought tolerant, erosion control, fragrant white flowers in summer, red berries in fall. Deer resistant.
Epimedium grandiflorum (Bishop's Hat)	  	12" x 18"	Semi- Evergreen	To -28°C	Nice fall foliage colours, delicate flowers in pink, red, yellow, and white in spring. Deer resistant.
Euonymus fortunei (Japanese Euonymus)		24" x 24"	Evergreen	To -28°C	Drought tolerant, variegated green/gold foliage.
Fragaria chiloensis (Beach Strawberry)	 	8" x 30"	Semi- Evergreen	To -28°C	Drought tolerant, erosion control, white flowers in spring. Deer resistant native. Light foot traffic.
Galium odoratum (Sweet Woodruff)	  	12" x 36"	Semi- Evergreen	To -38°C	Fast growing, dies down in winter, tiny white flowers, fragrant leaves when dried. Deer resistant.

Species	Exposure	Height / Spread	Foliage	Zone	Description
Gaultheria procumbens (Wintergreen)	 	6" x 24"	Evergreen	To -38°C	Moderate growing, white flowers followed by white berries in fall/winter. Deer resistant.
Gaultheria shallon (Salal)	  	24" x 24"	Evergreen	To -22°C	Drought tolerant, native plant, erosion control. Purple berries in fall. Deer resistant.
Herniaria glabra (Rupturewort)	 	2" x 16"	Evergreen	To -35°C	Drought tolerant and tolerant of high foot traffic. Low, dense grower.
Hypericum calycinum (St. John's Wort)	 	18" x 30"	Semi-Evergreen	To -35°C	Drought tolerant, fast growing, erosion control. Pretty bright yellow flowers.
Iberis sempervirens (Candytuff)	 	8-10" x 12-36"	Evergreen	To -3°C	Drought tolerant once established. Beautiful pure white flowers for several weeks in spring. Glossy, evergreen foliage. Performs best in well-drained soil.
Isotoma fluvitilis (Blue/White Star Creeper)	 	2" x 12"	Evergreen	To -22°C	Tolerant of moderate foot traffic, small soft blue prolific flowers in spring/summer. Fast growing.
Leptinella gruveri (Miniature Brass Buttons)	 	1" x 8-12"	Evergreen	To - 7°C	Great for planting in between flag stones in moist, shady areas. Very dense.
Leptinella squalida (New Zealand Brass Buttons)	 	2" x 12"	Evergreen	To -35°C	Tolerant of high foot traffic.
Lysimachia nummularia (Creeping Jenny)	 	2-4" x 18-24"	Semi-Evergreen	To -42°C	Very vigorous growing groundcover that is great as a trailer in container plantings. Available in either green or yellow leaves. Bright yellow flowers in summer.
Mazus reptans (Creeping Mazus)	 	2-4" x 12-18"	Evergreen	To -23°C	Very fast grower that forms a dense mat of green leaves with small lavender-mauve flowers in spring.

Species	Exposure	Height / Spread	Foliage	Zone	Description
<i>Mentha requienii</i> (Corsican Mint)	  	2" x 12"	Semi-Evergreen	To -22°C	Extremely fragrant when touched, tolerant of light foot traffic, requires moist soil. Deer resistant.
<i>Oxalis oregana</i> (Wood Sorrel)		4" x indef	Deciduous	To -16°C	Moderate grower, dies down in winter, drought tolerant. Native and deer resistant.
<i>Pachysandra terminalis</i> (Japanese Spurge)	 	10" x 12"	Evergreen	To -38°C	Fast growing, green or variegated foliage. Deer resistant. Slow to establish but tolerate poor soil.
<i>Pratia pendunculata</i> (Dark Blue Star Creeper)	 	2" x 2"	Evergreen	To -22°C	Tolerant of moderate foot traffic, prolific small flowers in spring/summer.
<i>Rubus calycinoides</i> (Creeping Bramble)	 	2" x 2'	Evergreen	To -17°C	Deep green, coarse leaves form a dense mat. Great for rock gardens or slope stabilization.
<i>Sagina subulata</i> (Irish or Scotch Moss)	 	2" x 14"	Evergreen	To -38°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic, tiny white fragrant flowers. Deer resistant. Irish – green foliage and scotch – chartreuse foliage.
<i>Sedum</i> spp. (Creeping Stonecrop)	 	8" x 18"	Semi-Evergreen	To -38°C	Fast growing, green, chartreuse, burgundy or variegated foliage. Drought tolerant with yellow, pink, or white flowers.
<i>Soleirolia soleirolii</i> (Baby Tears)	 	2" x 12"	Semi-Evergreen	To -6°C	Tolerant of light foot traffic. Requires moist soil. Forms a thick mat with pinkish-white flowers in Summer.
<i>Thymus</i> 'Albus'	 	3" x 14"	Evergreen	To -45°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic, white flowers and deer resistant.
<i>Thymus</i> 'Coccineus' (Red Thyme)	 	3" x 14"	Evergreen	To -35°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic, red flowers and deer resistant.
<i>Thymus</i> 'Pink Chintz' (Pink Thyme)	 	3" x 14"	Evergreen	To -45°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic, pink flowers and deer resistant.

Species	Exposure	Height / Spread	Foliage	Zone	Description
Thymus 'Purple Carpet' (Purple Thyme)	 	3" x 14"	Evergreen	To -45°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic, purple flowers and deer resistant.
Thymus minus 'Elfin'	 	1" x 18"	Evergreen	To -45°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic. Tiny leaves and lavender flowers. Deer resistant. Slow growing.
Thymus pseudolanuginosus (Wolly Thyme)	 	3" x 14"	Evergreen	To -45°C	Tolerant of drought and high foot traffic, pink flowers, and deer resistant.
Veronica 'Waterperry' (Creeping Speedwell)	 	1-2" x 10-12"	Evergreen	To -35°C	Great for rock gardens or edging along pathways. Small, soft-blue flowers in early summer.
Veronica whitleyi (Whitley's Speedwell)		4" x 18"	Evergreen	To -38°C	Drought tolerant and deer resistant. Soft silver mat like foliage. Bright blue flowers in late spring/summer. Moderate growing.
Vinca minor (Periwinkle)	 	8" x 30"	Eergreen	To -35°C	Drought tolerant, fast growing, green or variegated foliage with white, blue or purple flowers.
