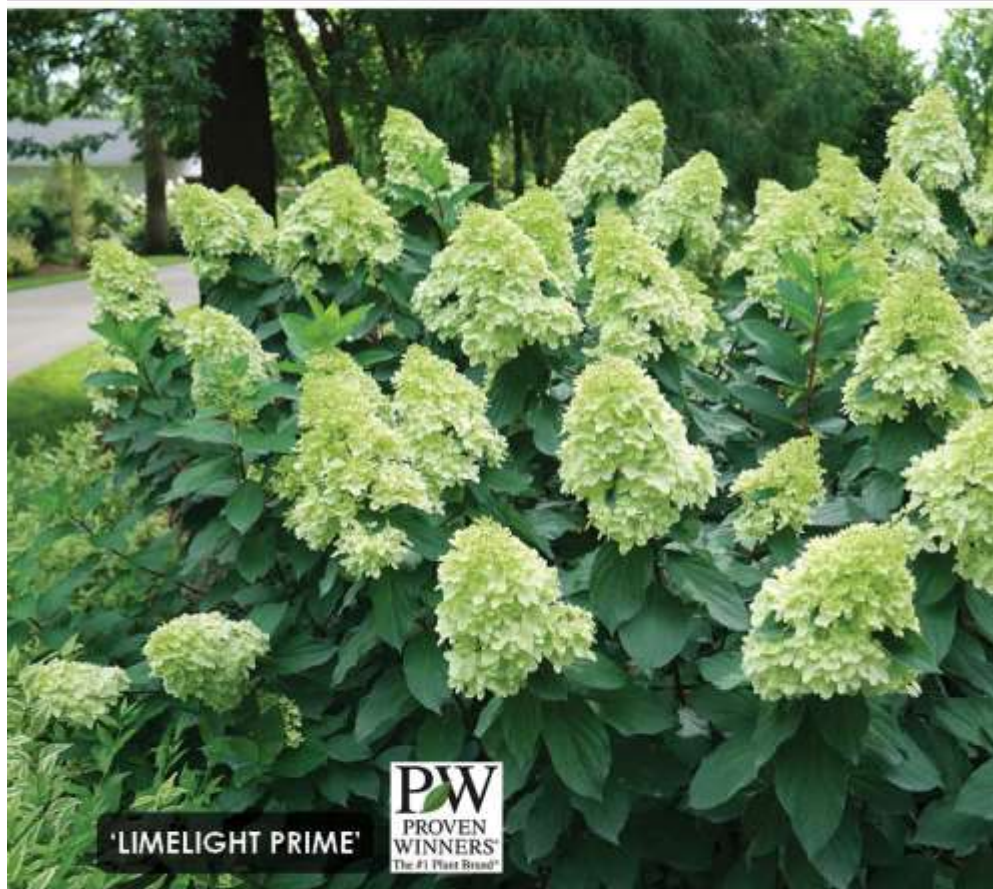

Pruning:

Proper pruning is the key to achieving healthy, lush, beautiful Hydrangeas. *Hydrangea macrophylla* and *Hydrangea serrata* need pruning to remove dead wood and thin spindly shoots. Late summer is the most popular time to prune since these shrubs only flower on old growth from the previous season. A general rule of thumb is to cut the old, dried flower heads back to the first pair of plump, green buds. To create a fuller plant, remove some of the weaker shoots at the base. By keeping several stems of old productive wood and stout new stems, the shrub will retain a lovely shape and bloom for next season.

Hydrangea quercifolia is a fabulous all-season beauty, with its unique oak-leaf shaped foliage, showy flowers, brilliant fall colours, and interesting winter bark. Its pruning requirements are similar to *Hydrangea macrophylla* and *Hydrangea serrata*, in that the flowers develop on old wood. Because of this, pruning should only take place when the flowers are finished and periodically removing a few of the older stems to the base to stimulate new growth. Oak-leaf Hydrangeas are slightly more delicate than other hydrangeas, and prefer a warm, sheltered location with partial shade.

Hydrangea paniculata and *Hydrangea arborescens* can be cut back hard in spring as these types will produce large blooms on the current season's growth. If many smaller flowers are preferred, then just a light trim in spring is all that is required. If a mass of blooms that encompasses the shrub is desired, prune stems at various heights. These hydrangeas leaf out later than other varieties, which make these species suitable for colder gardens. Their cream or greenish-white flowers make wonderful summer displays.

Soil and Color:

Hydrangeas are plants that enjoy being personalized. It is possible with some hydrangeas to manipulate their colour to suit your garden scheme or simply your personal colour preference.

To achieve blue flowers, the soil must be acidic. We are quite lucky in the Pacific Northwest to have these growing conditions occurring naturally, however if you wish to deepen the colour simply add Aluminum Sulphate to the soil.

To achieve pink flowers the soil must be alkaline. To achieve this you simply add Lime to the soil. Generally it is only the *hydrangea macrophylla* and *hydrangea serrata* that change their color. Most other hydrangeas will not.

Hydrangeas are very successful in the temperate Lower Mainland. Many are suitable for growing in containers and respond best to regular watering and fertilizing.

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Annabelle	White, Mophead	4-5' x 3-5'	Large white flowers throughout summer.
Incrediball	White, Mophead	4-5' x 4-5'	Huge Blooms! Strong stems ensure flowers don't fall over.
Invincibelle Lace	Pink, Mophead	4-6' x 4-6'	The first ever smooth hydrangea with gorgeous plum-purple lacecap flowers and dark ruby hued stems.
Invincibelle Limetta	Lime Green, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Gorgeous lime-green flowers on a nice, compact growing shrub.
Invincibelle Spirit II	Pink, Mophead	3- 4' x 3-5'	An improved version of the original Invincibelle Spirit with stronger stems and larger flowers.
Invincibelle Sublime	Green, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	A new day for full-sized smooth hydrangeas, with cloud-like mophead flowers floating above the plant on super-sturdy stems.
Invincibelle Wee White	White, Mophead	1-3' x 1-3'	The smallest growing H.arborescens ever! Flowers age to soft pink and green.
Lime Rickey	Lime Green, Mophead	4-5' x 3-4'	Lime-green, mophead flowers all summer long! Great for containers.
Pinkerella	Pink, Mophead	4-5' x 4-5'	Yellow-green flower buds open to bright pink flowers.

Plum Passion	Purple, Lacecap	5-6' x 5-6'	First ever purple foliage Hydrangea! Excellent fall colour.

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Cityline Mars	White & Purple, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Variegated white and purple/pink flowers from summer thru Fall. Great compact form. Great for containers.
Cityline Paris	Pink turning to a dark red, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Compact, well branched, mildew resistant, great for containers
Let's Dance Big Band	Purple, Pink Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Combines big mophead flowers with pure, true colors on a plant that survives winter better and reblooms better.
Let's Dance Blue Jangles	Blue, Pink, Purple Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	A big-leaf hydrangea that blooms on both old and new wood, with a compact habit that is unusual among reblooming hydrangeas.

	Let's Dance Can Can	Rich Violet or Pink, Lacecap	4' x 3'	Continually produces new flowers all the way until August
	Let's Dance Diva	Baby Blue or Pink, Mophead	3-4' x 3-4'	Huge flowers! Re-blooms all summer long.
	Let's Dance Rhythmic Blue	Amethyst Blue or Pink, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	One of the most reliable re-blooming Hydrangeas.
	Let's Dance Starlight	Pink or Blue Lacecap	2-3' x 2-3'	Gorgeous pink lacecap flowers. Blooms summer thru Fall.
	Onyx Flamingo	Pink or Blue Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	A compact, bushy deciduous shrub boasting large, baby-pink mophead flowers.
	Tilt-A-Swirl	Red & Green, Mophead	3-4' x 3-4'	Flowers continue to transform color all season long. Continuous bloomer.
	Wee Bit Giddy	Bright Red or Red Violet, Mophead	30" x 30"	The most intense red Hydrangea available. Very hardy.

	Bobo	White, Panicle	2-3' x 3-4'	One of the first Hydrangeas to bloom! Huge show of pure white flowers all summer long.
	Fire Light	White to red, Panicle	5-6' x 5-6'	Large white flowers turn dark pink with age.
	Firelight Tidbit	Pink, Red and White Panicle	2-3' x 2-3'	Big, lush panicles of white mophead flowers appear in early-mid summer, nearly obscuring the textured green foliage.
	Lavalamp Candelabra	Creamy White to Deep Red, Panicle	4-6' x 4-6'	Large white flowers turn bright red as the summer progresses.
	Lavalamp Flare (Limited Qty)	White to Red, Panicle	2-3' x 2-3'	Great compact habit. White flowers age to a bright red-pink.
	Lavalamp Moonrock	Creamy White, Panicle	4-6' x 4-6'	Creamy white blooms with lime centre keep their colour all summer long.
	Limelight	Lime Green, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	Excellent vigour and very floriferous. Makes excellent cut flowers.
	Limelight Prime	Green, Pink, Red Panicle	4-6' x 4-5'	Blooms much earlier, creating a longer display. This is especially valuable in colder climates.
	Little Lime	Lime Green, Panicle	3-5' x 3-5'	Dwarf form of the 'Limelight' Hydrangea. Great for containers. Blooms summer thru Fall.

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
 Little Lime Punch	Green, Pink, Red, white Panicle	3-5' x 3-5'	Flowers change progressively from the bottom up in a gorgeous array of white, light pink, and rich Hawaiian Punch red
 Little Quick Fire	White turning Red, Panicle	3-5' x 4-7'	Flower quickly age from white to red before other varieties even begin to flower.
Phantom	Cream to Pink Panicle	4-6' x 4-6'	A heavy bloomer with sturdy-stemmed flowers that do not flop.
 Quickfire Fab	Pink, Red, White Panicle	6-8' x 5-6'	The earliest blooming mophead panicle hydrangea - enjoy extra weeks of blooms
 Zinfan Doll	White to Red-Pink, Panicle	4-6' x 4-6'	Blooms emerge white and fade to a dark red-pink from the bottom up.

Hydrangea quercifolia

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
 Gatsby Gal	Pure White, Panicle	5-6' x 5-6'	Great compact grower. Flowers are huge compared to shrub size.
 Gatsby Pink	White to Pink, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	Flowers change from pure white to deep pink. Foliage is gorgeous red in fall.
Sikes Dwarf	White panicle flowers, Panicle	2-3' x 3-4'	Tall white flowers bloom throughout summer.

Hydrangea serrata

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
 Let's Dance Arriba!	Pink, Blue, Purple	2-3' x 2-3'	One of the most prolifically flowering, fastest-growing reblooming hydrangeas we've seen!
 Let's Dance Can Do	Pink, Blue, Purple	3-4' x 3'	Reblooms quicker than others: in other words, you won't have to wait until fall to see the new flowers.
 Pink Dynamo	Pink, Lacecap	2-3' x 2-3'	A light pink around the edges with white and yellow accents near the center.
 Tiny Tuff Stuff	Blue, Lacecap	18-24" x 18-24"	Nice compact habit. Very vigorous bloomer. Can turn pink depending on soil acidity.
 Tuff Stuff	Pink, Lacecap	2-3' x 2-4'	Flowers open white and turn to intense pink in early summer.
 Tuff Stuff Ah-Ha	Blue or Pink, Lacecap	2-3' x 2-3'	Huge dinner plate sized double-flowers. Blooms continuously spring-fall.

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Tuff Stuff Red	Red-Pink or Blue Lacecap	2-3' x 3-4'	Flowers open two toned green & red and turn deep red as the season progresses.

Fairytrail Bride	White	2-3' x 2-3'	Its summer borne florets are filled with deckle-edged petals, bringing a frilly, lacey look to the landscape. TM
