

Pieris

Pieris is an attractive, easy to grow showy spring shrub that has cascading white, pink or red flowers and thrives in sunny or shady situations. It is best to add a soil amendment such as, Home & Garden Excellence Tree and Shrub Soil. Fertilize with Home & Garden Excellence Rhodo and Azalea food.

	Name	Color	x Width	Plant Characteristics
	Cavatine	White	3-4' x 3- 4'	Compact, dense habit with glossy green foliage.
	Cupido	White	4' x 4'	Dark burgundy buds form in fall, opening to pure white flowers in spring. Great compact form.
	Flaming Star	White	8' x 8'	Provides chains of greenish white flower buds in winter.
	Forest Flame	White	6-10' x 3-5'	Foliage emerges bright red and then turns to pinkish- white as the spring progresses, eventually turning green for summer.
	Insterstella (Limited Quantity)	Ruby red & white	3-4' x 3- 4'	Extremely early to bloom, and blooms are very long lasting.
	Karenoma	White	4-6' x 3- 4'	The most cold-hardy Pieris. Flowers are white and upright.
	Katsura	Rose	4-6' x 4- 6'	New foliage emerges dark red and turns to green as the season progresses. Great for containers.
	Little Heath	White	3-4' x 3- 4'	Neat, compact shrub with vellow variegated foliage.



Mountain Fire	White	2-3' x 2- 3'	Fiery red new growth turns green with age.
Prelude	White	3-4' x 3- 4'	Clusters of pure white flowers on short stalks shine against rich, dark green foliage on a densely branched globe shaped form.
Purity	White	3-4' x 3- 4'	New growth is bronzy red. Nice compact form.
Pygmaea	White	2' x 2-3'	A compact, mound- forming, evergreen shrub
Sarabande	White	3' x 3'	Pure white lily-of-the-valley like flowers in the spring
Scarlett O'Hara	White	5-6' x 4- 5'	Foliage is dark, glossy green, bronze to red when young.
Valley Rose	Pink	3-5' x 3- 5'	Flowers open light pink and turning to solid white. New growth is dark red.
Valley Valentine	Red	5-7' x 5- 7'	Attractive red foliage when young. Excellent mounding habit.
