Blueberries

Name	Fruiting Time	Information
Blue Crop	Mid	A great blueberry plant for colder climates. Produces big clusters of large, all-purpose berries
Chandler	Mid to Late	Chandler is celebrated for producing some of the largest blueberries available, with a sweet and slightly tart flavor.
Chippewa	Mid	Very cold hardy, medium sized fruit, firm & fine flavour
Duke	Early	Vigorous, upright, productive, large/firm, mild flavour.
Jelly Bean	Mid-Summer	A dwarf blueberry variety reaching 1–2 feet in height with a mounded form. Berries are medium to large, offering a taste reminiscent of sweet blueberry jelly.
Northblue	Mid	Sweet, dark blue berries. Very cold hardy.
Northcountry	Mid	Produces clusters of blue round berries which are usually ready for picking in mid summer.
Northland	Early	Features an abundance of magnificent blue berries from early to mid summer.
Patriot	Early	Exceptionally vigorous grower. Earliest of all Blueberries to fruit.
Peach Sorbet	Mid	In most climates, the plant retains its leaves during winter, turning a rich eggplant purple. White bell-shaped flowers appear in spring, leading to an abundant summer crop.
Pink Icing	Mid	The plant produces large, robustly flavored berries and is well-suited for decorative patio pots or landscape planting.
Polaris	Early	A very hardy hybrid blueberry of upright spreading habit, produces flavourful light blue fruit in early summer
Reka	Early	It produces medium-sized berries with a tangy, sweet-tart flavor. The shrub reaches about 4–6 feet in height and displays vibrant red foliage in the fall.

Blackberries

Name	Information
Baby Cakes	A compact, dwarf blackberry variety perfect for small spaces, containers, and home gardens. This thornless, upright-growing plant produces large, sweet, and juicy blackberries in mid-to-late summer, with the potential for a second smaller crop in fall.
Black Satin	This thornless, heat tolerant blackberry is a prolific producer of deliciously sweet and juicy, deep blue-black berries - that can be harvested without getting pricked by thorns!

Blackberries

Name	Information
Columbia Star	Columbia Star has the beloved Marionberry in its lineage and the flavor of these large berries has been rated as good or even better than the Marionberry!
Hardy Black (Thorny)	A robust, cold-hardy variety prized for its abundant crops of large, sweet, and juicy blackberries.
Illini	An erect, self-fruitful, thorny shrub, which produces one crop of fruit per year.

Currants

Name	Information
Black Crandall	Large, sweet, black-blue currants that ripen late in the season.
Primus	Primus White Currant is a stunning fruiting hedge that produces heavy crops of incredibly sweet berries that are high in vitamin C.
White	Large clusters of pink, red, white or black berries cascading down the heavily laden branches

Gooseberries

Name	Information
Black Velvet	Produces a heavy crop of gorgeous red-black berries that have a sweet, blueberry-like-flavour.
Little Ben	Little Ben is a compact bud sport of Hinnomaki Red that stays very compact and is extremely productive.
Pixwell	This Gooseberry shrub is most known for its high fruit yields with no significant flowers that appear.

Grapes (Seedless)

Name	Colour	Information
Einset	Red	Berries are medium-sized and crack resistant, which gives them good keeping quality.
Fiesta	Green	A very early ripening white table seedless grape
Neptune	Green	This variety produces big, juicy grapes with bold flavor. Conical clusters stay together.
Red Flame	Light Red, Purple Hue	A popular table grape cultivar renowned for its sweet flavor and seedless nature.
Suffolk Red	Red	Produces open bunches of bright red fruits. The soft skins of this variety make the fruits almost melt in the mouth.
Thompson Seedless	Pale Green	Oval shaped, seedless Grape variety renowned for its sweet flavor and versatility.

Grapes (With Seeds)



Name	Colour	Information
Valiant	Deep blue to purple	The Valiant Grape is an excellent choice for gardeners in colder climates seeking a reliable and flavorful grape variety.

Grapes (Wine Making)

Name	Colour	Information
Emerald	Green	These grapes will grow in massive clusters. Great variety to eat fresh off of the vine, process into wines, jam, and jellies.
Limberger	Purple	Used to produce low acid, varietal wines.

Honeyberries (Haskaps)

These very early ripening, tasty berries are hardy to -50 degrees C. Very easy to grow with no pest or disease problems. Two Varieties with similar bloom time are needed for pollination.

Name	Description
 Yezberry Maxie	Delicious, juicy berries that taste like a cross between a raspberry and blueberry. Plant with Yezberry Solo to maximize production.
 Yezberry Solo	Large, sweet berries that are great for fresh eating or making into sauces, jams or desserts. Plant with Yezberry Maxie to maximize production.

Hops

There are two types of Hops used in home brewing:

1. Aroma: Lower in Alpha-acids and are used in conditioning and finishing.
2. Bittering: Higher in alpha-acids and are used to add bitterness

Name	Description
Cascade	Aroma Hops. Vigorous grower that contributes fragrance and a light bitterness to home brews. Used to make West Coast style Craft Ales. Mildew resistant. Used Central City Brewers in their Red Racer 'Red Ale' and 'White as well as by Trading Post Brewery in their 'Hop Session Lager' and 'Breakfast Stout'
Chinook	Chinook hops are suitable for any stage of the boil. They're not only a natural for American-style Pale Ales and IPAs, but they also find their way into seasonal ales, barley wine and some porters and stouts.
Summer Shandy	While it produces small hop cones, it is mostly valued for its ornamental appeal rather than its brewing qualities.



Kiwi

Kiwi fruit (*Actinidia deliciosa*) is a small, oval-shaped fruit known for its fuzzy brown skin and vibrant green or golden flesh. It has a unique sweet-tart flavor with a juicy, slightly tangy taste, complemented by tiny, edible black seeds. Rich in vitamin C, fiber, and antioxidants, kiwis are both nutritious and refreshing. The fruit thrives on vigorous, climbing vines and requires a warm, temperate climate for optimal growth. Kiwis are commonly eaten fresh, added to fruit salads, blended into smoothies, or used as a garnish in desserts, making them a versatile and delicious addition to any diet.

Name	Description
Actinidia arguta 'Anna'	Delicate white flowers in late spring. Sweet bite-sized fruit. Pest & disease resistant. Ripens in late summer. Requires a pollinator.
Actinidia arguta 'Issai'	Very vigorous grower. Self-fertile. Produces an abundance of small, delicious, smooth skinned fruit.
Actinidia arguta 'Prolifica'	Prolific is self-fertile and will independently yield delicious, grape-sized fruit.
Actinidia deliciosa 'Saanichton' (Female)	A heavy producer of large, sweet and flavorful fruit.
Actinidia deliciosa 'Fuzzy Matua' (Male)	Male cultivar of the kiwifruit vine, primarily utilized as a pollinator for female kiwifruit varieties such as 'Hayward', 'Saanichton', and 'Vincent'. While it does not produce edible fruit, 'Matua' is essential for successful fruit set in female plants.
Actinidia deliciosa 'Male'	Male fuzzy kiwis will usually take 1-3 years to mature to flowering age, and can stretch up to 40' long.
Actinidia kolomikta 'Arctic Beauty' (Male)	Beautiful white & pink variegated foliage. Very fragrant flowers. Use to pollinate September Sun Kiwi.
Actinidia kolomikta 'September Sun' (Female)	Beautiful variegated foliage & fragrant white flowers. Use Artic Beauty or Pasha to pollinate to get fruit.

Pomegranate

Name	Description
Wonderful	A highly popular fruiting shrub or small tree known for its large, deep red fruit with juicy, sweet-tart arils. It produces vibrant orange-red flowers in spring and summer, attracting pollinators before giving way to its antioxidant-rich fruit in fall.

Raspberries (Summerbearing)

Name	Description
Black Raspberry	A wonderful thornless blackberry that can be eaten fresh off the vine! Easy to grow in sun or shade.
Nova	This hardy variety boasts large, flavorful berries bursting with sweetness, perfect for fresh eating or preserving.
Raspberry Shortcake	A dwarf, thornless raspberry variety that reaches a compact height of approximately 2 to 3 feet. Its rounded growth habit makes it ideal for container gardening or small spaces. In mid-summer, typically around June and July, it produces full-sized, sweet, and aromatic red raspberries.

Raspberries (Summerbearing)

Name	Description
Red Bounty	Large and flavourful, excellent for fresh eating and great for processing.
Saanich	Produces a very high yield of medium-sized, firm, sweet fruit
Squamish	Conical shaped, very bright and glossy in appearance and medium red in colour.

Raspberries (Everbearing)

Name	Description
Amity	Large, dark red berries with beautiful flavour.
Chemainus	The fruit is red, sweet and tart, and some varieties ripen in Summer
Heritage	Late Season, yields flavourful medium sized red fruit, very vigorous, winter hardy, disease resistant
Kokanee	Bright red, glossy, gorgeous fruit, uniform in shape and consistently medium to large.
Tulameen	Tulameen uniquely extends the summer raspberry season through July and August, producing for up to 50 days.

Rhubarb

Name	Description
Victoria	Needs lots of sun, but will produce in a lightly shaded area. Easy to grow and makes delicious pies!

Elderberry

Name	Description
John's	Green foliage has an appealing gloss to add landscape interest to this bush. Giant clusters of white flowers bloom in spring, becoming soft, nearly black berries in late summer.
Nova	Slightly shorter than many <i>S. canadensis</i> varieties, it's a great choice for smaller or urban gardens.
Ranch	Semi-spur-bearing plant, which means lots of production. Has an upright vs. bushy growth habit.
Wyldewood	Green lance-shaped foliage surrounds huge 12" white-petaled flower heads that bloom with a lemony scent in midsummer, followed by rich purple berries.

Seabuckthorn

Name	Description
Hergo Female	With the help of a male plant, the Hergo sea buckthorn female or <i>Hippophae rhamnoides</i> Hergo provides an abundance of fruit from October onwards.
Pollmix Male	Pollmix male sea buckthorn will pollinate several surrounding female varieties (such as <i>Hippophae rhamnoides</i> 'Askola').

Miscellaneous

Name	Description
Aronia - Viking	Attractive medium-sized shrub with prolific spring flowers, attractive edible purple fruit and outstanding red fall foliage.
Boysenberry	A large, deep maroon berry resulting from a hybrid between the European raspberry, European blackberry, American dewberry, and loganberry. The fruit is known for its sweet-tart flavor and is especially valued for canning, preserving, and use in pies and cobblers.
Jostaberry	Produces deep purple to nearly black berries that are slightly smaller than gooseberries but larger than blackcurrants. The flavor is a harmonious blend of its parentage, offering a mellow gooseberry taste with hints of blackcurrant.
