Planting Instructions

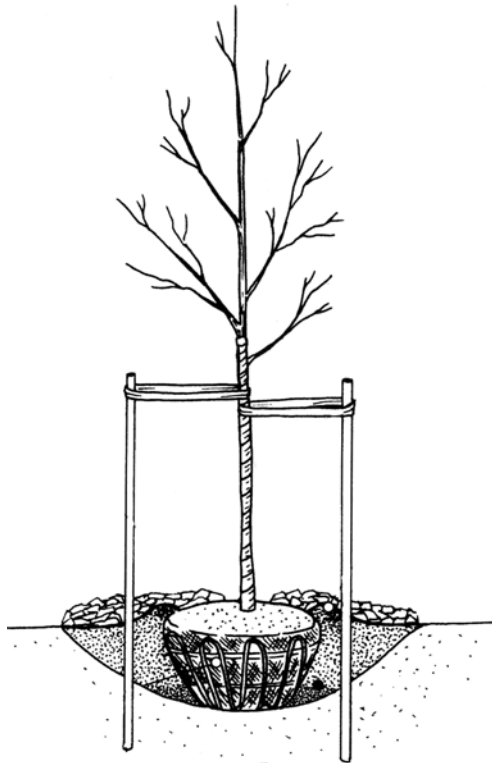
Here at Cedar Rim Nursery, we recommend you follow these steps to properly plant your landscape plants. It is most important that you select a location that meets the plant's needs for light exposure, soil moisture and drainage.

Site Preparation

Plants added to your landscape will grow best when planted in native soil or in soil that is uniform in structure and texture throughout the rooting area. Cedar Rim recommends that if you amend your soil, do so for a large area such as an entire landscape bed, not just a planting hole.

To amend large areas, place two to four inches of organic matter over the entire area. Work the organic material into the soil to a depth of six inches or more. Suggested amendments include compost, processed steer manure and peat moss. Thoroughly mix fertilizer into the amended soil. Cedar Rim recommends bone meal and sea soil as soil amendments.

If your soil does not drain well, consider creating a berm by mounding an enlarged planting area. To accomplish this, re-grade the area, add topsoil, and add compost so the root ball of the landscape plant is above the previous grade. When adding topsoil, work some into the top four to six inches of native soil before adding more.



Planting hole

Dig a planting hole that is twice as wide and only as deep as the plant's root ball or container. Place the plant in the hole so that the top of the root ball is at, or slightly above, the surrounding soil. (Never place the tree deeper than its original soil height.)



7 Simple Tips for Gorgeous Hydrangeas

1. Choose a location with well-draining yet moist soil.
2. Follow our planting instructions
3. Put down 2-3" of Home & Garden Aged Bark around the base of the plant (this helps with moisture retention)
4. Water deeply 2 to 3 times per week during warm periods.
5. Fertilize with Home & Garden Rhodo, Azalea & Acid Loving Plants Fertilizer (8-10-16) in the spring.
6. Prune dead branches in late winter/early Spring.
7. Enjoy vibrant blooms from late spring to fall with regular care!



Have Pink flowers but want Blue?

Simply add Home & Garden Aluminum Sulphate to the soil.

Have Blue Flowers but want Pink?

Add Home & Garden Dolomite Lime to the Soil.

Hydrangea arborescens (Smooth Hydrangea)



Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Incrediball	White, Smooth	4-5' x 4-5'	Huge Blooms! Strong stems ensure flowers don't fall over.
Incrediball Stormproof	White, Smooth	4-5' x 4-5'	Strong-stemmed, compact deciduous shrub; produces abundant, long-lasting white blooms from summer to fall.



Invincibelle Lace	Pink, Smooth	4-5' x 4-5'	The first ever smooth hydrangea with gorgeous plum-purple lacecap flowers and dark ruby hued stems.
Invincibelle Sublime	Green, Smooth	3-5' x 3-5'	A new day for full-sized smooth hydrangeas, with cloud-like mophead flowers floating above the plant on super-sturdy stems.
Invincibelle Wee White	White, Smooth	1-3' x 1-3'	The smallest growing H.arborescens ever! Flowers age to soft pink and green.
Lime Rickey	Lime green, Smooth	3-4' x 3-4'	Compact smooth hydrangea with strong stems and vibrant lime-green blooms in summer



Hydrangea macrophylla (Big Leaf Hydrangea)



Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Cherry-Go-Round	Deep Red, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Deep cherry-red flowers arrive in late spring and continuously bloom through summer and fall.
Cityline Paris	Pink, Red, Mophead	1-2' x 1-3'	One of the smallest hydrangeas on the market, it does not need pruning (in fact, don't prune it at all!)
Eclipse	Cranberry or Amethyst, Mophead	3-5' x 3-5'	When grown in alkaline soils will have cranberry flowers, while those grown in acidic soils will have amethyst flowers.
Endless Summer Bloomstruck	Rose-pink or Blue-purple, Mophead	3-4' x 4-5'	Has extremely strong stems, above average heat tolerance, and great disease resistance, especially to powdery mildew.
Endless Summer Blushing Bride	White, Mophead	3-6' x 3-6'	Pure white semi-double flowers that mature to blush pink.
Endless Summer Pop Star	Electric Blue or Bright Pink, Mophead	18-36" x 18-36"	A compact hydrangea that blooms like nothing you've seen before, blooming profusely from top to bottom, all season long.
Endless Summer Summer Crush	Raspberry Red or Neon Purple, Mophead	18-36" x 18-36"	Only grows to a mature size of 18 to 36 inches tall and wide, so you can count on it to stay small, neat, and tidy throughout the season.
Endless Summer The Original	Pink or blue, Mophead	3-5' x 3-5'	Deciduous bigleaf hydrangea with large, long-lasting blooms; flowers on both old and new wood, allowing multiple flushes of blooms from summer to fall.

Endless Summer Twist N' Shout	Dark Pink, Mophead	3-5' x 3-4'	Sturdy stems that are vivid red
Grin and Tonic	Lime green to white, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	The blooms emerge lime green and age to a refreshing bright white
Let's Dance Blue Jangles	Blue, Pink, Purple, Mophead	1-2' x 2-3'	A big-leaf hydrangea that blooms on both old and new wood, with a compact habit that is unusual among reblooming hydrangeas.
Let's Dance Lovable	Blue, Pink Mophead	3-4' x 3-4'	Hundreds of flowers from old and new wood. Its blooms are intensely colored pink, purple, or blue depending on the soil chemistry.
Let's Dance Rhythmic Blue	Blue or Pink, Mophead	3-4' x 3-4'	Combine into dozens of lush, full, mophead flowers that are pink in alkaline soils and a fabulous blue in acidic conditions
Let's Dance Starlight	Blue or Pink, Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Large, vivid lace-cap flowers every summer. Blooms every summer. Good for cutting. Soil pH affects flower color.
Magical Bride	White, Mophead	2-4' x 2-3'	Pure white flowers with hard blooms and strong stems for cuts
Starfield	Pink or Blue Mophead	2-3' x 2-3'	Pink in neutral soil, and blue/mauve in acidic soil, all summer long.
Tilt-A-Swirl	Red, Green, Mophead	3-4' x 3-4'	Whimsical bicolor flowers transform into new red and green variations from spring to fall.
Wedding Gown	White, Mophead	2-3' x 3-5'	Starts as a lacecap and fills into a mophead
Wee Bit Giddy	Bright Red or Red Violet, Mophead	2' x 2-3'	Later on in the summer, you'll get to enjoy a flush of new wood flowers.
Wee Bit Grumpy	Bright Red or Purple, Mophead	2' x 2-3'	They appear amid a neat, tidy mound of compact foliage that resists disease and stands up better to cold weather than most hydrangeas.
Wee Bit Innocent	Pink, Blue or Purple, Mophead	2' x 2-3'	Reblooms in fall

Hydrangea paniculata (Panicle Hydrangea)









Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Berry White	White, Pink, Panicle	5-6' x 4-5'	Upright smooth panicle hydrangea with strong stems; produces large, long-lasting cone-shaped blooms from mid to late summer
Bobo	White, Pink, Panicle	2-3' x 3-4'	It is compact and dwarf in habit, and the flowers cover every inch of the plant right down to the ground
Fire Light	Pink, Red, White, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	Large white flowers turn dark pink with age.
Firelight Tidbit	Pink, Red, White Panicle	2-3' x 2-3'	Big, lush panicles of white mophead flowers appear in early-mid summer, nearly obscuring the textured green foliage.
Limelight	Lime Green, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	The blooms age to an array of pink, red, and burgundy which persists through frost for months of irresistible flowers
Limelight Prime	Green, Pink, Red, Panicle	4-6' x 4-5'	Blooms much earlier, creating a longer display. This is especially valuable in colder climates.
Little Lime	Lime Green, Pink, Panicle	3-5' x 3-5'	Small enough to grow in containers and also stands out as a bold mass planting.
Little Lime Punch	Green, Pink, Red, White, Panicle	3-5' x 3-5'	Flowers change progressively from the bottom up in a gorgeous array of white, light pink, and rich Hawaiian Punch red
Little Quick Fire	White turning Red, Panicle	3-5' x 3-5'	White flowers transform to pink-red as summer progresses
Phantom	Cream, Pink Panicle	6-10' x 6-10'	A heavy bloomer with sturdy-stemmed flowers that do not flop.
Puffer Fish	White, Panicle	3-5' x 3-5'	Fluffy white blooms that engulf the entire plant, nearly obscuring the foliage.
Quickfire Fab	Pink, Red, White, Panicle	6-8' x 5-6'	The earliest blooming mophead panicle hydrangea - enjoy extra weeks of blooms
Tiny Quick Fire	White, Pink, Panicle	2-3' x 2-3'	Compact, dwarf panicle hydrangea with strong stems; produces abundant, long-lasting cone-shaped blooms from mid to late summer
Vanilla Strawberry	White, Pink, Red, Panicle	6-8' x 4-5'	The blooms are white at first, they begin to transition to a pale pink & mature to a deep strawberry red color.

Hydrangea quercifolia (Oakleaf Hydrangea)




Ideally morning sun with dappled afternoon shade

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
 Gatsby Gal	Pure White, Pink Panicle	5-6' x 5-6'	Full panicles of pure white blooms are held upright above the foliage
 Gatsby Glow Ball	White, Soft Pink, Panicle	5-7' x 5-7'	Large, showy cone-shaped blooms and deeply lobed, oak-like foliage that provides strong fall colour.
 Gatsby Moon	Green, White, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	The tightly packed, pure white florets create very full, conical panicles with a unique 'quilted' effect.
 Gatsby Pink	White, Pink, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	Flowers change from pure white to deep pink. Foliage is gorgeous red in fall.
 Gatsby Star	White, Pink, Panicle	6-8' x 6-8'	The result is a beautiful, lacy panicle - and a very showy plant
Harmony	White, Panicle	5-8' x 5-10'	Large, dense cone-shaped white flower clusters that may gracefully arch as blooms mature.
Jet Stream	White, Pink, Panicle	5-6' x 4-5'	Strong stems holding abundant white flowers that age to pink, dark green foliage
Sikes Dwarf	White, Pink, Panicle	3-4' x 3-4'	Tall white flowers bloom throughout summer.
 Toy Soldier	White, Green, Panicle	4-6' x 3-5'	Foliage turns mahogany in fall and remains on the plants long into the winter season

Hydrangea serrata (Mountain Hydrangea)



Ideally morning sun with afternoon shade

Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
 Let's Dance Can Do	Pink or Violet, Lacecap	3-4' x 4'	A strong and fast rebloomer. Displays of abundant semi-double, star-like florets through frost.



Tuff Stuff	Pink or Blue, Lacecap	2-3' x 2-3'	Less affected by cold winters than big-leaf hydrangeas, but equally colorful and showy
Tuff Stuff Ah-Ha	Blue or Pink, Lacecap	2-3' x 2-3'	Double florets look like pink or blue waterlilies.



Hydrangea x (Cascade Hydrangea)



Name	Colour & Flower Type	Height x Spread	Plant Characteristics
Fairytrail Bride	White, Pink, Lacecap	3-4' x 3-4'	Its summer borne florets are filled with deckle-edged petals, bringing a frilly, lacey look to the landscape.™
Fairytrail Green	Creamy Green, Lacecap	4' x 4-5'	Suited for containers, hanging baskets, and areas in the landscape where it can drape dramatically
